



## EQUITY & ACCESS

### Instructions

1. Designate a Recorder and a Reporter for your table.
2. Walk through one question at a time (spend 10 minutes on each question).
3. The Recorder should use the flipchart to capture one idea at a time in a “round-robin” format until all ideas have been exhausted.
4. Once all ideas have been added to the flipcharts, each member will use the black dot stickers to identify the ideas of highest priority from all responses to both questions (spend no more than 5 minutes prioritizing).
5. Please use only one sticker, per idea, per person.
6. The Reporter will then present the table’s top 5 priorities to everyone.

### Discussion

The AEC is a publicly-owned, Dane County asset and should be welcoming and accessible to all members of our community. The AEC Visioning process is an opportunity to think big about how the AEC can best reflect our community’s equity and access goals.

Below are two questions addressing equity and access for the table to discuss. The designated Recorder should use the flip charts to capture the table’s ideas, in a “round-robin” format.

1. What are the kinds of positive impacts the AEC’s redevelopment can have on the neighborhoods that would benefit community goals? Responses to this question should be in the following form:

The AEC should     (type of impact)     for     (target group/neighborhood)    .

*Example: The AEC should **create walkable employment opportunities** for **local residents.***

*Example impacts may include walkable jobs, workforce training, affordable housing, etc.*

2. How can the AEC be a more accessible, welcoming, and valued asset to our counties diverse communities and cultures (e.g. disabled residents, low-income residents, minority communities, seniors, youth)? Responses to this question should be in the following form:

The AEC should     (type of impact)     for     (target group)    .

*Example: The AEC should **improve wheelchair accessibility on campus** for **visitors with disabilities.***

*Example impacts may include cultural events, multilingual signage, senior programming, low cost events, ethnic food, etc.*
